The FreeStore is a place of mutual sharing centered on the exchange of donated, new or pre-used goods. Whether through volunteering, shopping, donating goods, or just grabbing a cup of coffee, everyone can participate and contribute.

All interested persons are invited to become a member of the FreeStore, with no restrictions on membership. No one must prove their income level. Each member receives a membership card and is able to take a set number of items per month, depending on available inventory.

You can arrive anytime on Saturday morning between 9:00 a.m. and 12:00 p.m. You should enter through the Red Double Doors at 1502 Edgehill Avenue. Here you will find a casual, inviting atmosphere where you can drink coffee, partake of snacks, and visit with other free store members. Hosts will greet you and show you what to do.
