

Who is eligible?

Girls of all faiths and ethnic backgrounds are welcome. They must be in 7th through 12th grades and live in the Edgehill neighborhood. After high school graduation, members of The Spot are encouraged to mentor younger girls.



What does it cost? How do I join?

All programs of The Spot are free. Simply come to The Spot at 1414 Edgehill. A volunteer will provide a simple registration form.

Who runs the program?

The Spot is a program of the non-profit Edgehill Neighborhood Partnership (ENP). The program is designed by the girls who must agree to a code of conduct based on mutual respect. Volunteers ensure emotional and physical safety, provide food and transportation, implement programming, and model appropriate behavior. With the exception of some special programming and services offered by professionals, volunteers are women.

What does The Spot offer?

The Spot offers a safe place for girls to hang out; to learn respect for each other; and to grow stronger academically, emotionally, spiritually, and socially.



What are some of the activities?

- Computers are available for completing homework and improving computer skills.
- Study skills
- Tutoring
- ACT preparation
- Healthy interpersonal skills (e.g., relationship building, appropriate assertiveness, decision making, listening, addressing bullying, understanding cultural differences, learning compassion)
- Field trips (e.g., Frist Center for the Visual Arts, the Nashville Zoo, zumba lessons at the Global Education Center, the W.O. Smith Community Music School, the Nashville Farmers' Market, Vanderbilt University, etc.)
- Sewing
- Poetry/creative writing
- Movies
- Cooking and nutrition
- Drug and alcohol education
- Physical health
- Financial literacy



Where and when does it meet?

The Spot meets in the red house at 1414 Edgehill Ave. after school every Tuesday and Thursday that school is in session. In the summer, sewing and computer skills are offered at 10 a.m. on Thursdays, and field trips are offered on a flexible schedule. Gardening is offered during the summer at the community garden behind the Edgehill library.
